7.5.0	21 Sep 2023	<p><u>Repeating Content Controls</u> When the user makes changes to multiple content controls with the same title in a paragraph, the value from the leftmost control will be applied to the occurrences.</p> <p>Numbering is applied to occurrences when making a proposed change to a repeating content control with numbering (PR-28090)</p> <p>Tracked changes without strikethrough are shown in the review when a proposed change is made to a pre-existing space (PR-28485)</p> <p>Incorrect tracked changes and whole control is in strikethrough when making changes to repeating content controls with the same title but having different styles (PR-28696)</p> <p>No strikethrough is applied to open proposed changes when the text remains identical before and after the change (PR-28989)</p> <p>The entire control is in strikethrough when user modify a word within the control that contains a field code (PR-29188)</p> <p>Original text is used for tracked changes on repeating content control after merging multiple proposed changes (PR-29344)</p> <p>Get error when make proposed change by enter new line without space (PR-30465)</p> <p><u>SCIM</u> <u>Applicable to Azure AD and Okta</u> To enable group provisioning, it is necessary to include Workgroup and role mapping groups in the Identity Provider settings.</p> <p>Before syncing the role mapping groups, it is essential to first synchronize the Workgroup to PleaseReview.</p> <p>Users have the flexibility to be included in multiple role mapping groups within the Identity Provider. Nevertheless, it's important to note that the role assigned to a user in PleaseReview will be determined based on the most recent role mapping group provisioned. Consequently, users should ideally be added to just one of the role mapping group that best align with their roles or responsibilities.</p> <p>Removing the Workgroup from the Identity Provider will result in the deletion of both the Workgroup and the associated role mapping group(s) in PleaseReview. However, it's important to note that the role mapping group(s) will still remain in the Identity Provider.</p> <p>Able to modify the workgroup name within the Identity Provider for a role mapping group even after it has been synchronized with PleaseReview.</p> <p>The workgroup is provisioned into PleaseReview as an unlocked workgroup, meaning that any user in the PleaseReview system can be added to it.</p> <p><u>Specifically for Okta</u> Okta Integration Network (OIN) is not supported (PR-29640)</p>

		<p>Deadlock exception will occur when there are concurrent API calls to save subject (PR-30591)</p> <p>Encountered issues when attempting to update, deactivate, or delete a user with a native extsource. (PR-30616)</p>
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
